Procedures for running for office

1. Each candidate must complete the candidate application form to become eligible to run for Student Council. The Election application can be found on the Jr. High page of the school website, in the Jr. High Office, and with Mr. Schiffmacher and/or Mr. Pesca.
2. When petitions are returned to Mr. Schiffmacher and/or Mr. Pesca, students will be officially registered as candidates for office.
3. All applications are due to Mr. Schiffmacher and/or Mr. Pesca by Monday, September 18.
4. All applicants **MUST** attend a meeting on Monday, September 18 **after school** to discuss the responsibilities of candidates and officers.
5. Campaign posters may **ONLY** be hung on the walls of the Junior High Wing and Cafeteria B. Mr. Schiffmacher, Mr. Pesca or Dr. Browne must approve and sign all posters before they can be hung up.
6. The election assembly speeches for grade 7 and 8 will be held during each of the lunch periods on Wednesday, September 27 for 8th grade and Thursday, September 28 for 7th grade. The election speech of each candidate must be approved by Mr. Schiffmacher and/or Mr. Pesca before it can be delivered.
7. The election of officers will be held during homeroom, Friday, September 29.

PRESIDENT (1)	-	MUST BE IN 8 TH GRADE
VICE-PRESIDENT (2)	-	1 FROM EACH GRADE
SECRETARY (2)	-	1 FROM EACH GRADE
TREASURER (2)	-	1 FROM EACH GRADE
SAC ADVISORS (2)	-	1 FROM EACH GRADE

Note: Student supporters may only sign **ONE** petition for each office.
